Last 40 Years:

After 40 years in the Egyptian court, and 40 years behind the desert, Moses was 80 years old when he first approached Pharaoh (Ex.7:7). God worked through Moses to bring 10 plagues upon Egypt, the last of which finally persuaded Pharaoh to let the children of Israel go. You do not have to be out in the desert for God to speak to you – He is speaking to you now, if you will listen, through His Word.

Moses forever stands as an inspiration of hope, faith, courage and commitment. He refused to compromise, he stood firm in the face of difficulty and suffering, he led his people against impossible odds and ultimately gave his life that others might enter the promised land. My Story, My Voice

On October, 2010 I was admitted to a private hospital in Trivandrum with high fever and nausea. None of the treatment seemed to work and my condition grew steadily worse and I was admitted to the ICU. My condition was deemed to be highly critical and my body systems like liver and kidney showed signs of failure. The doctors were helpless as they could not identify the problem and I almost reached a point of no return. But although this, my church and many people around the world were praying earnestly for me. The doctors advised my family to shift to another prominent Hospital in Tamil Nadu to receive specialized care.

On the night of my transfer, I heard a voice in ICU saying, "Even though You walk through the Valley of the shadow of death, Do not fear; for I am with you". Hearing this voice at a time when I felt alone and hopeless, gave me faith, courage and hope that whatever might happen, I am safe in the hands of my Lord Jesus. Later, I was shifted to the hospital in Tamil

Nadu, where my disease was identified as Drug, Rash, Easnohil and Systemic symptoms (DRESS Syndrome), an allergic reaction to a drug that I was administered in the other hospital. I underwent a long treatment and finally I was discharged from the hospital. But my internal organs were damaged and I had some problems after my hospital discharge. I started attending the church worship and my body started healing during the worship. Each of my systems started to be normal and after the seventh Sunday, my body healed completely and I was given a clean bill of health by medical professionals. The doctors were astonished at my normal results and even they too praised God.

I have known people who had died from less serious diagnoses than me. Thinking of it all, I praise and thank God for curing me so perfectly. I also thank my church and hundreds of unknown people who have prayed for my recovery.

My life once again proves that Jesus Christ is alive and He still can work wonders in our lives if we just trust in Him.

Praise The Lord. I attended a fasting prayer meeting in Nagpur. Based on the message, I would like to divide Moses' life into 3 parts. Deut.34:7 tells us he died at the age of 120. Therefore, we will divide his life into three equal parts of 40 years each.

First 40 Years:

We Can see his first 40 years was spent in the Egyptian court (Acts 7:20-23). The Bible says that "Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians" (Acts 7:22). This would include mathematics, chemistry, engineering, architecture, astronomy, poetry, philosophy, music, and all branches of learning. The point I am trying to make here is that those whom God would use, He carefully prepares. And this is clear from the life of Moses.

Second 40 Years:

Moses spent 40 years on the behind the desert as God prepared him for his great assignment (Acts 7:23-30). Moses met God that day at the burning bush, and his life changed forever. God had a plan for Moses. Moses felt that the job description God had in mind for him was beyond his capabilities. In spite of Moses' arguments, God did not let him off the hook. God put Moses into the land of Midian and gave him a "BD degree," i.e. the behind the Desert degree. but you better make sure you get your "BA" – i.e., "Born Again!"

We sometimes do the same thing, we argue with God, why me for this Job, but God had some other plans and he will not let us off the hook. Once God hold you, he will never leave you.
